



## Setting File Permissions for a Standard Windows User (Non-Administrator)

To set up an I'mOnIt! user that is not a system administrator on the local system

1. Define the user as a standard user:

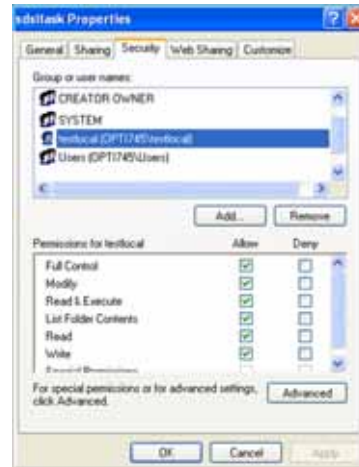
- Control Panel
- User accounts
- Select the desired user and click “Properties” button



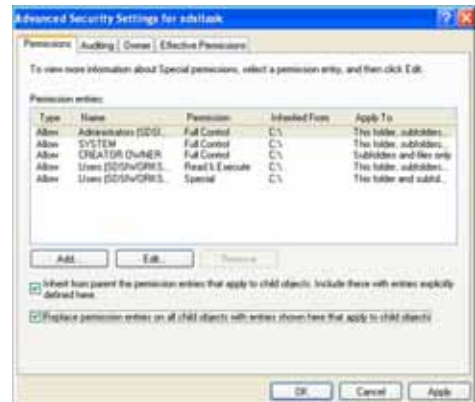
2. On the Properties dialogue, Select the Group Membership tab
- a. Select “Standard User”
  - b. Click OK



3. Set the folder security
  - a. Browse to the folder c:\sdsitask.
  - b. Right-click on the folder and select “Properties” from the dropdown menu
  - c. Add the user as an explicitly Authorized user for the folder,
  - d. Click the check box to the left of the “Full Control” option.



4. Click Advanced
  - a. Check the checkbox “Replace permission entries on all child objects with entries shown here that apply to child objects”



5. Click OK twice to close all dialog boxes

The same procedure works for domain based / active directory controlled user accounts.
