

Setting File Permissions for a Standard Windows User (Non-Administrator)

To set up an I'mOnIt! user that is not a system administrator on the local system

- 1. Define the user as a standard user:
 - Control Panel
 - User accounts
 - Select the desired user and click "Properties" button




- 2. On the Properties dialogue, Select the Group Membership tab
 - a. Select "Standard User"
 - b. Click OK



- 3. Set the folder security
 - a. Browse to the folder c:\sdsitask.
 - b. Right-click on the folder and select "Properties" from the dropdown menu
 - c. Add the user as an explicitly Authorized user for the folder,
 - d. Click the check box to the left of the "Full Control" option.



- 4. Click Advanced
 - a. Check the checkbox
 "Replace permission entries on all child objects with entries shown here that apply to child objects"
- 5. Click OK twice to close all dialog boxes



The same procedure works for domain based / active directory controlled user accounts.

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
